S. W. Inspector's Report for 1890

"An advance has been made upon the work of last year but Spelling and Arithmetic are weak in the upper standards. English was imperfectly prepared, the grant is barely earned, Grammar being very weak. The songs are given with taste, but the Musical Instruction, though given with intelligence, is not sufficiently successful to warrant the higher grant at present. Order and Needlework are satisfactory."
