 Severe illness has broken out in  
 our village several children away  
 with the mumps.  
 26<sup>th</sup> Continued illness brings down very  
 Feb: materially our numbers.  
 3<sup>rd</sup> Commenced the Standards today.  
 11<sup>th</sup> Visitors Mr. & Mrs. Morgan.  
 14<sup>th</sup> Gave half holiday, Throve Tuesday.  
 23<sup>rd</sup> We have frequently lately had 5, 6,  
 and 7 Children present out of a  
 class of 21 - Similar irregularity in  
 other classes owing to illness.  
 3<sup>rd</sup> Rector visited the school.  
 Usual work, but few children.  
 18<sup>th</sup> Took Spelling instead of reading  
 in Stan. II.  
 17<sup>th</sup> Very disheartening numbers present.  
 24<sup>th</sup> Rector has called today, also Mr. Morgan.
