

April 1st I called the Children's Names this morning at 11-20 A.M. & found that the Registers had been correctly marked. G.F. Morgan

2nd Closed School today for Easter Holiday of 10 days.

13th Re-opened School. Illness having abated we have better numbers. Admitted Henry and Charles Swift.

22nd Reproved several Children for being late, but did not punish, owing to distance their homes are from School. They lost their mark of attendance.

1st Equal poor attendance on Friday. Some Children invariably stay away on that day. I find Friday's attendance a great drawback both to progress and average attendance for the week.

May 7th 1875 The numbers have fallen off today, only 43 Children present. Mr. Morgan has visited the school. Heard that four children the Gallans, are leaving the village & therefore the school.

15th Very poor attendance today.

18th Admitted Amelia and Phoebe Chambers.

19th Rector called with the notice of examination to take place June 2nd.

25th Long Holiday being Whit Monday.

28th Examined the Registers this morning & found them correctly marked. G.F. Morgan

June 2nd No school this morning owing to examination at 2.30 in the afternoon.
