June
Friday 3rd - Woke up today for Whitsun holidays

Friday 17th - Commenced school on Monday after a week's holiday - 5 children came on Monday afternoon who have been ill with scarlet fever! Did not take them in - afraid to do so without advice from a doctor - as the consequences might prove very serious - heard that another family are attacked also with the same disease - admitted one - attendance only moderate - been working up for examination this week which takes place on Tuesday

Friday 24th

Examination took place on Tuesday - had only 41 to present - 6 away, who were eligible, through illness - Gave half holiday on Tuesday morning so that children might come clean and tidy in the afternoon -

July

Friday 1st - Diocesan Inspection took place on Wednesday morning - Gave half holiday in the afternoon - Had a fair report from Mr. Cousins - attendance pretty fair through the week -

Friday 8th

Two families returned this ~~week~~ ^{week} who have been away several weeks with fever - attendance fair - average 46 - several elder children away hay making -
