1841 Teversal Tithe and Apportionment Index

The apportionment is the descriptive part of the award, created subsequent to the Tithe Commutation Act of 1836, which gives details of owners and occupiers of individual plots of land within a parish, together with a description (fieldname), state of cultivation and acreage.

The records of the Tithe Survey may show where people were living and who their neighbours were in early Victorian times. You may also find information on crop acreages, field names, house occupancy, rights of way and parish boundaries.
