

Planting at Teversal for view.

This Plantation is required for the double purpose of hiding cottages from the view at Teversal Manor and for increasing the beauty of the foliage.

The following points should be borne in mind;-

1. The tallest trees should be furthest from the Manor.
2. The most ornamental trees should be nearest the Manor.
3. There should be a sufficient variety of foliage.
4. Between the two sides should be the trees that will either:-
 - (a) Grow most rapidly,
 - (b) Become the tallest,
 - (c) Produce most foliage,
 - (d) Have foliage in winter.
5. If these conditions can be secured then the trees that will grow the most useful timber when required to be cut down should be selected.
6. Plants are of no use that are not sufficiently strong to satisfy these conditions.
